Overview This one-year course (Sept –May) aims to equip students with the knowledge, skills and understanding required to work effectively in the area of Interior Design. The course aims to develop technician level skills in Interior Design and provides learners with the key skills to undertake residential and commercial interior design projects. This course offers a broad training relevant to employment in a large number of areas that require knowledge, awareness and skills in the design and furnishing of interior spaces.

- Develop design solutions to match briefs for clients
- Allow the student to develop skills in the use of a variety of materials from timber to furnishings.
- Allow the individual learner design his/her own pieces, interiors and mood boards
- Prepare learners for third level courses in Design and Architecture
